Practical Guide to Thessaloniki-Transport, Attractions and Useful Contacts

This document provides practical, concise and formal information for conference attendees. It includes: public transport (OASTH) connections between Thessaloniki Makedonia Airport (SKG) and the city centre, routes to and from the Thessaloniki Concert Hall (Megaro Mousikis), a short catalogue of principal attractions and museums with estimated travel times from the Concert Hall, useful contact numbers and a small leaflet containing QR links to key services.



1. Arrival: From Thessaloniki Makedonia Airport (SKG) to the City Centre

- Line 01X (day service): connects Thessaloniki Airport with central city stops including Aristotelous Square and the Central Railway Station. Frequency: approximately 2–3 departures per hour during daytime. Journey time to the city centre: approximately 30–40 minutes depending on traffic.
- Line 01N (night service): operates during night hours. Journey times vary; expect a slightly longer travel time compared to daytime services.



- Tickets: purchase on board where available or via official mobile apps / authorized retail points. Fare conditions and concessions are published by OASTH.

2. Transport: City Centre ⇌ Thessaloniki Concert Hall (Megaro Mousikis)

The Thessaloniki Concert Hall (Megaro Mousikis) is located on the seafront (25th Martiou & Paralia). The venue is served by several OASTH bus lines. Closest



stops: '25is Martiou' and 'Megaro Mousikis-25is Martiou' (short walk to the main entrance).

Common public transport options:

- Bus lines serving the Concert Hall (examples): 01X / 1X, 03K, 05, 06, 30, 70, 71A. Frequencies and exact stopping patterns vary by line and time of day.
- Metro: With the recent opening of the Thessaloniki metro, line information may provide alternate, faster connections—consult real-time metro maps for the day of travel.

• Taxi: Taxis can be hailed in the street or booked via local radio-taxi networks and apps (see contact list). A taxi from Aristotelous Square to the Concert Hall typically takes 8–15 minutes depending on traffic. From the Airport, a taxi can take 20–30 minutes.

3. What to see

The following list identifies principal attractions and museums in Thessaloniki.

Estimated times are provided from Megaro Mousikis (Thessaloniki Concert Hall) and are indicative (subject to traffic and exact route).





White Tower

On foot along the Nea Paralia promenade: approximately 45–70 minutes walking; by taxi: c. 10–20 minutes; by bus: 10–20 minutes depending on route and waiting times.



Archeological Museum of Thessaloniki

By bus (e.g., 01X via Town Hall/Dimarchiako Megaro stop and short walk): c. 20–30 minutes; by taxi: c. 15–25 minutes.



Aristotelous Square

By taxi: c. 8–15 minutes; by public transport: c. 10–20 minutes depending on line and stops.



Museum of Byzantine Culture

By taxi: c. 12–20 minutes; by public transport or on foot from central stops: c. 15–25 minutes.



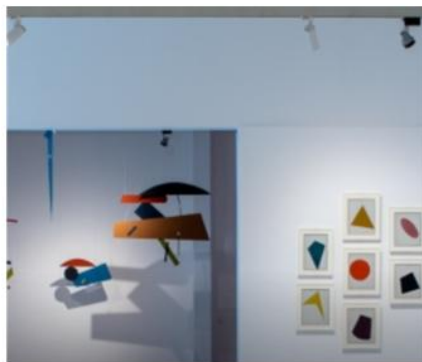
Rotunda & Arch of Galerius

By taxi: c. 8–15 minutes; by public transport: c. 10–20 minutes.



Ano Poli Eptapyrgio

By taxi: c. 15–25 minutes; allow extra time for walking within the historic neighbourhood.



State Museum of Contemporary Art/MOMus

By taxi or public transport: c. 15–25 minutes; check opening hours and temporary exhibitions prior to visit.



Atatürk Museum

By taxi or public transport: c. 10–20 minutes; located near central area.



Ladadika District

By taxi: c. 10–15 minutes; by public transport: c. 10–20 minutes.



Note: For multi-site planning, consider combining the Nea Paralia, White Tower, and Aristotelous Square as a single walking route (morning/afternoon). For museum visits, consult respective official webpages for opening hours, ticketing and temporary closures.

5. Practical tips for Conference Attendees

1. Plan transfers to/from the airport in advance; allow at least 60–90 minutes for luggage and transit when scheduling flights.
2. Check museum opening hours and book tickets online when possible to avoid queues.
3. Validate OASTH schedules on the day of travel (mobile apps and OASTH website provide live updates).
4. If arriving late at night, prefer radio taxis or pre-booked transfers.
5. Allow extra time for taxi journeys during peak hours (morning/evening commute).
6. For visitors with mobility requirements, check accessibility information on venue and transport operator websites.

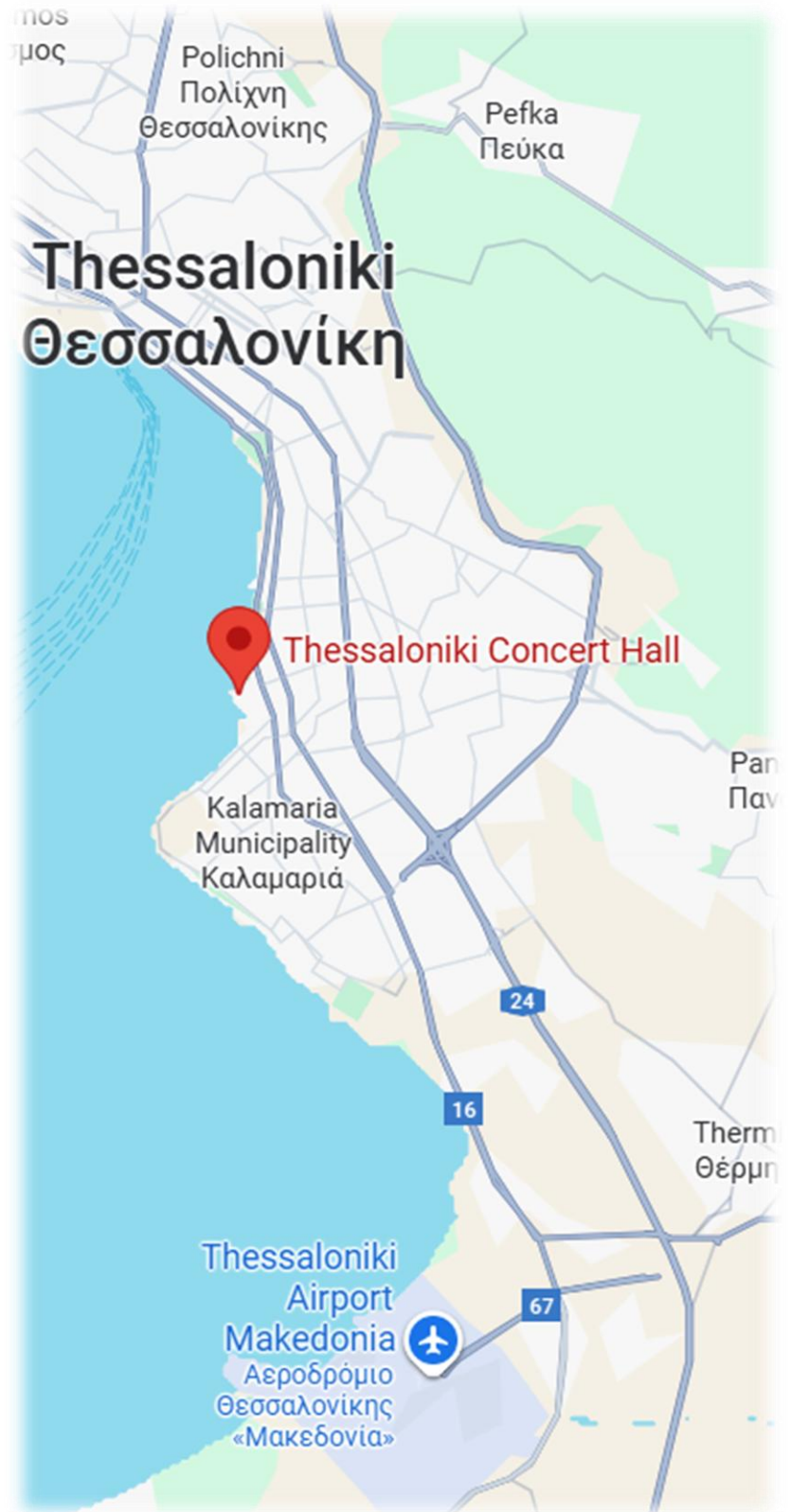
